



IRONMAN LEEDS ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

SUNDAY 27th JULY 2025

SHADWELL, THORNER, SCARCROFT, BARDSEY, EAST RIGTON, WIKE, HAREWOOD, ALWOODLEY, ECCUP, ARTHINGTON

We are delighted to announce that the inaugural IRONMAN Leeds triathlon is coming to Leeds on **Sunday 27th July 2025**. The event is a long-distance triathlon which consists of a 2.4 mile swim, 112 mile bike and 26.2mile run with over 2,400 athletes competing. The event hub including the Athlete registration, merchandise, swim, transition and finish line will be located in Roundhay Park.

Temporary road closures will be in place on IRONMAN Leeds weekend to ensure the safety of athletes and the public.

These legal road closures are implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994, and apply to all vehicles, bikes and horses that are not involved in the event.

- Please avoid parking on the bike course for safety reasons.
- Pedestrians **CAN** cross the course at any time when safe to do so.
- Essential access for carers will be facilitated. Please contact leeds@ironmanroadaccess.com
- There are **NO RESTRICTIONS** at any time to any of the emergency services.

AREA	CLOSURES	DETAILS
SHADWELL	06:00 - 18:00	Shadwell is the lap point for the cyclists during the event at the junction of Bay Horse Lane and Main Street. Cyclists starting their bike course will enter Shadwell using Main Street before continuing straight on towards Thorner. Main Street and a section of Bay Horse Lane will be FULLY CLOSED from 06:00 - 18:00. Cyclists lapping will be using Wike Ridge Lane, Tarn Lane and Brandon Lane/ Bay Horse Lane before turning left to start their next lap. Wike Ridge Lane, Tarn Lane and Brandon Lane will be FULLY CLOSED 07:30 - 17:30. ACCESS ADVICE: Residents of Shadwell are advised to avoid the named roads and use the westbound access in and out during the road closures to avoid any delays.
THORNER, BRAMHAM, WOTHERSOME	06:00 - 15:30	The course will follow Carr Ln before turning right in Thorner on to Main St. The bikes will travel south on Main St / Lower Sandhills and U-turn before the Skeltons Ln Junction. The bikes will then travel north using Main Street and Church Lane / Bramham Rd/Thorner Rd to Wothersome. The above named roads are FULLY CLOSED 06:00 - 15:30. ACCESS ADVICE: Access to The Arium Garden Centre is advised from Skeltons or Thorner Lns. Access out of Thorner is available using a contraflow system on Kirkfield Lane. Please see the website for the detailed map showing where to park to use the exit route.
SCARCROFT, BARDSEY	06:00 - 16:00	The roads in Scarcroft and Bardsey are not closed however do fall within the route. There are 2 x crossings available for residential and business throughout the day. Please note there may be delays when using the crossings. (Please see the map overleaf). Crossing Point 1 (South) at the junction of the A58 (Wetherby Rd) /Carr Lane is available for residents of Scarcroft, Bardsey and East Rigton to use throughout the day. Crossing Point 2 (North) at the junction of the A58 (Wetherby Rd) / Wood Lane / Church Lane is available for residents of Scarcroft, Bardsey and East Rigton to use all day.
EAST RIGTON	06:30 - 16:00	The course turns left onto Thorner Ln / Holme Farm Ln then left onto Mill Lane / Wood Lane. The course crosses the A58 (See CP 2 above) and follows Church Lane before turning right on to Woodacre Lane and left onto Keswick Lane /Wike Ln/ Backstone Gill Ln towards Wike. The above named roads are FULLY CLOSED 06:30 - 16:00.
WIKE, HAREWOOD, A61	07:00 - 16:30	The course turns right from Backstone Gill Lane onto Forge Ln/ Wike Lane before turning right onto Harrogate Rd (A61). The course travels north on the A61 and u-turns before the Harewood House Junction and continues south towards Leeds Grammar School. The above named roads are FULLY CLOSED 07:00- 16:30. ACCESS ADVICE: Access to Harewood House is available from the north using the A61 and east and west using the A659 throughout the day.
A61, ALWOODLEY GATES	07:00 - 17:30	The course continues south on the A61 and u-turns around the roundabout outside Leeds Grammar School before turning left using the unnamed road across Eccup Reservoir. The named section of the A61 will be FULLY CLOSED 07:00 - 17:30.
ECCUP, WEARDLEY, ARTHINGTON	07:30 - 17:00	The course will continue along the unnamed road over Eccup Reservoir and onto Eccup Moor Road before taking a sharp right onto Eccup Lane / Weardley Lane. The course then turns left onto the A659 (Arthington Lane) and then turns left for the climb up Black Hill Road. The course follows Arthington Rd south towards Alwoodley. ACCESS ADVICE: The A659 (Arthington Lane) will be closed WESTBOUND ONLY from 07:30-17:00. All other named roads will be FULLY CLOSED from 07:30-17:00.
ALWOODLEY, ADEL, BLACK MOOR	07:30 - 17:30	The course turns left from Church Lane onto Back Church Lane and left again onto Stair Foot Lane. The course then turns left onto King Lane and right onto Alwoodley Lane. The course continues onto Wigton Lane before turning right onto Wike Lane. ACCESS ADVICE: Back Church Lane and Stair Foot lane will be FULLY CLOSED from 07:30 - 17:30. Alwoodley Lane / Wigton Lane will be closed EASTBOUND ONLY from 07:30 - 17:30.
