All dogs must be REGISTERED at The Royal Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If the registration or transfer of ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by The Royal Kennel Club. Puppies under six months of age on the first day of the show cannot be entered for competition. On no account will entries be accepted without fees. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after its name. Please put classes in numerical order and USE BLOCK CAPITALS throughout when completing this entry form. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

It is most important to put your correct postal address on the entry forms. Failure to do so may result in your passes being delayed or not received by you at all.

Address should include:

CHEQUES

The Society name must be written in full or your cheque will be returned.

The banks are now scanning cheques as you pay them in. Cheques that are not written using black ink, or don't have the society name written in full, will be rejected. Failure to follow the above criteria means your entry will be returned.

WELFARE OF DOGS

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Royal Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Royal Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Royal Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Right to Refuse Entries: Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Royal Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.

CARAVANS

£30 if paid with entries, £40 if paid on arrival (for the duration of the show or part thereof).

Space on the caravan site is limited and early booking is advised with the Secretary.

Caravans will be parked in a separate eight-acre field adjacent to the showground and linked by a tarmac footpath. Facilities include a toilet block (including disabled), shower block (in main building and accessible 24 hours), chemical disposal point and a fire point. A woodland site is available for exercising dogs on the strict understanding that dogs are kept on a lead at all times and any fouling is removed immediately, as this is a picnic area.

Caravans will be allowed on the site from 12 noon on Monday 12th January and must be removed by 12 noon on Monday 19th January 2026.

Please note that each caravan will be allocated a space of 10 metres in width. All equipment, including awning, windbreaks etc. must be contained within the allocated space and individual units must not be linked. Caravans/Motor homes over 8 metres in length are required to book and pay for two pitches.

The site will be under the control of the Society's appointed wardens and anyone not complying with his/her instructions will be asked to leave the site.
