ATTENTION ALL EXHIBITORS

- JUDGING ARRANGEMENTS: Judging will start at 8.30am in certain rings. The Show closes half an hour after judging is completed.
- PASSES WILL BE SENT: Passes will be printed out and posted to exhibitors that enter by post.
- ADMISSION: For General Public, admission can be payable on the door or can be prepurchased via eventbrite.
- NOT FOR COMPETITION: Dogs may be entered NFC. Fees detailed separately in this Schedule.
- **MEMBERSHIP** (from 1st Jan 2026): Exhibitors are reminded that membership of G.B.A.S. is open to all, and you are invited to join. The annual subscription is £10.00 Single, £12.00 Joint (i.e. Husband and Wife, two members of the same family or two bona-fide partners); £5.00 Junior (under 16 years of age). Applications to the Hon. Secretary.
- FIRST AID: First aid personnel will be on hand throughout the show.
- VETERINARY SERVICES: These will be available if required from the Veterinary Surgeon who will be in attendance for the duration of the show.
- CATERING: Catering will be provided by onsite SEC catering and will be available throughout the duration of the show.
- CLEANLINESS AND EXERCISE AREA: A large public attendance is expected at the show and exhibitors and handlers are asked to assist by observing the highest standards of dog cleanliness. This applies particularly to the show entrance and walkways. Please use the litter bins provided for all paper, refuse, etc., and help us to retain this venue by keeping it clean and free of litter. The exercise area for dogs will be outside Hall 4 and will be signposted. Please do not trespass on any part of the venue outside the Dog Show Area and exercise your dogs only in the exercise area provided for you. Exhibitors and handlers will be expected to clear up any fouling by the dog(s) in their charge. Whilst special containers for use by exhibitors and handlers and if possible, equipment to deal with fouling will be provided, this will not absolve those responsible for dogs being properly equipped. Special stewards will be on duty in an effort to ensure that the foregoing requirements are carried out and the dog-showing public is encouraged to assist by active participation and by reporting those who fail in their responsibilities to the Show Management and, if necessary, The Royal Kennel Club.



VENUE OF CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

GBAS will have our championship show at Scottish Event Campus in Glasgow. All breeds will be on ground level and there will be Trade Stands offering a wide variety of merchandise. RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. The Show will open at 7.30 am.
- Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitors responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
- Judging will commence at 8.30 am.
- 4. Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to The Royal Kennel Club.
 - The show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed by which time dogs must be removed.
- 5. Entry Fees: Non-Members first entry with CC's £32.00. Members first entry with CC's £30.00. Non-Members first entry without CC's £17.00. Members first entry without CC's £15.00. All subsequent entries with same dog £6.00. Stakes Classes/YKC Members' Stakes as a first entry per dog £17.00. KC Breeders Competition £15.00. ADULT/YKC Handling £5.00 per Entry. Not for Competition £12.00. Brace £5.00. Catalogues £8.00 pre-paid; £9.00 on day of show. Car Parking FREE for Exhibitors ONLY and PASSES MUST BE DISPLAYED. You may enter online at www. highampress.co.uk.
- 6. Prize Money will not be paid with the exception of certain stakes classes.
- 7. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 8. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible for exhibition.
- 9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is forbidden.
- 10. Best Puppy in Show (if scheduled). Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. The selection of Best in Show may follow the selection of Best Puppy in Show and Best Veteran in Show (if scheduled) respectively. Where the Best of Breed, Best of Group or Best in Show is a puppy it may, at the discretion of the judge, be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Where the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best in Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it may, at the discretion of the judge, be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group or Best Puppy in Show respectively.

Championship Shows Judged on the group system

(Definition; Shows judged on group system - Refer to Regulation F(1)27.b)

1) Best Puppy in Breed

A Best Puppy may be declared in each breed from puppies entered and unbeaten by another puppy in the breed classes.

A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes.

A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes

2) Best Puppy in Group

Best puppy in group and subsequent puppy group placings must be selected from:-

- a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed.
- b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes.
- c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes.
- 11. Best in Show. The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register. Definition of a Category 3 Breed. A breed from time to time designated by the Board as requiring particular monitoring by reason of visible condition(s) which may cause health or welfare concerns. The list of designated Category 3 Breeds is kept under regular review.
 - Best of Breed. Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared. NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/Best Any Variety

- Imported Breed Register award relevant to a Category 3 will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant group.
- Best in Show. Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining group winners following the selection of Best in Show.
- 12. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- 13. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them <u>nor handle a dog in a</u> <u>manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move.</u> This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Royal Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- 14. All exhibitors must be familiar with Royal Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- 15. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Royal Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 16. DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Royal Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
 - When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - · When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for
 extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter
 and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

- 17. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Royal Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Royal Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under the Royal Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Royal Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
- 18. **Not for Competition:** Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Royal Kennel Club registered.
- 19. No modifications will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the Board of The Royal Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 20. An exhibitor or competitor should ensure that contact details for any handler are available and must be provided upon request in any investigation of a breach of this regulation by such handler.
- 21. CANCELLATION OR ABANDONMENT: Entry fees will not be refunded in any circumstances where any Act of God or any other unforeseen reason causes the cancellation or abandonment of the show.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club.

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the first closing date shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. **Wednesday 8th October 2025**.

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. First prizes awarded in any classes defined as Special do not count towards eligibility.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

- (1) Withdrawal
 - The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulation F.(1).19.
- (2) Transfer
 - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer It to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. **PUPPY** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

YEARLING For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. **NOVICE** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

GRADUATE For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

POST GRADUATE For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

MID LIMIT For dogs which have not become show Champions under Royal Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won five or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Mid Limit, Limit or Open Classes confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

LIMIT For dogs which have not become show Champions under The Royal Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/ Green Stars or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN For all dogs of the breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

VETERAN For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a Challenge Certificate or Reserve Challenge Certificate, or for those breeds not allocated Championship Status, Best of Sex or Reserve Best of Sex at a Championship Show.

NOT FOR COMPETITION Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed.

IMPORTED BREED REGISTER For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by The Royal Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this

class with the Best Imported Register / Best Imported Register Puppy being eligible for Best in Group / Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show / Best Puppy in Show as relevant. Such breeds may be entered into Imported Breed Register classes and/or Any Variety or Stakes classes, with the exception of AVNSC classes, for which they are not eligible.

YKC STAKES— i. This schedule information MUST be read in conjunction with the full set of YKC Stakes rules available on the Young Kennel Club website.

- a. By entering this class, you confirm that you have read and understood the accompanying full set of YKC rules
- ii. Members must be a YKC member before entering the competition
- iii. YKC Stakes Classes have one age category for you to enter
- a. 06-24 Years
- iv. First place in each subcategory will guarantee qualification to Crufts 2026
- a. Further qualification methods can be viewed by reading the full rules
- b. You may enter this class even if you have previously qualified in this class
- v. YKC Classes may be the first and only entry at this show.

YKC HANDLING CLASSES— i. This schedule information MUST be read in conjunction with the full set of YKC Handling rules available on the Young Kennel Club website.

- a. By entering this class, you confirm that you have read and understood the accompanying full set of YKC rules
- ii. Members must be a YKC member before entering the competition
- iii. YKC Handling Classes have 3 different age categories for you to enter: a. 06-11 Years; b. 12-17 Years;
- c. 18-24 Years
- iv. May enter a dog from one of the 8 different groups: a. Utility; b. Toy; c. Terrier; d. Hound; e. Working; f. Pastoral; g. Gundog; h. Crossbreed
- v. Bitches in season are not allowed to compete in YKC Handling classes
- vi. A record of the dog's Royal Kennel Club registered name along with the handler's name will be kept, this will determine which class they enter at Crufts (and by extension which day)
- a. After entries have closed, competitors may only switch dogs if both: (1) The dog is in the same group;
- (2) The dog is already entered at the show
- vii. Members should enter the age category they would be on the first day of this show.
- viii. First place in each subcategory will guarantee qualification to Crufts 2026
- a. Further qualification methods can be viewed by reading the full rules
- b. You may enter this class even if you have previously qualified in this class.

PUPPY STAKES Open to all puppies of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR STAKES For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. **YEARLING STAKES** For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

POST GRADUATE STAKES For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

VETERAN STAKES For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

CHAMPION STAKES For dogs, which have been confirmed, a Champion or Show Champion under Royal Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club.

FIELD TRIAL STAKES For dogs which have won prizes, Diplomas of Merit or Certificates of Merit in actual competition at a Field Trial held under Royal Kennel Club or Irish Kennel Club Field Trial Regulations.

BRACE STAKES For two exhibits (either sex or mixed) of one breed belonging to the same exhibitor, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

OPEN STAKES For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show. **MEMBERS' OPEN STAKES** For Any Variety Dog or Bitch, exhibited and handled by a MEMBER OF G.B.A.S. If a dog is owned by a partnership, both must be members.

GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME CLASS For dogs that have achieved their GCDS Bronze Award Certificate or above. ROYAL KENNEL CLUB BREEDERS' COMPETITION — Each team will consist of a minimum of three and maximum of four dogs of one breed, all bred by the same breeder or breeding partnership. The breeder enters the class and then arranges which dogs are exhibited on the day of the show. Please clearly state the name and affix of the registered breeder(s). Entries will not be taken on the day of the show. Teams will be awarded points/prize money in the KC Breeders' Competition as follows: Points 1st; 30; 2nd 15; 3rd 10; 4th 5. Prize Money £25 for the winner of each group. These points will be recorded in the Royal Kennel Club Breeders Competition record book through the year. The top 40 teams will qualify including the winning teams from the European and World Dog Shows' breeders competition. Our Dogs will collate the points and publish a leader board through the year.

ADULT HANDLING A class to be judged on handling, open to all dogs; the entry being restricted by the age of the handler in each class.

Regulations For The Preparation of Dogs For Exhibition F (Annex B)

- These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Royal Kennel Club licensed event. Objections may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Royal Kennel Club Rule A11.
 - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
 - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A11.
- (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's
 coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of
 any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show.
 - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:-
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the Board.
 - (b) The removal of dew claws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to The Royal Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.

Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the Board to deceive.

- 4. The Board without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from The Royal Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by The Royal Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Royal Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the show secretary at his/her office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

- 2. Please DO NOT enter dogs belonging to different owners on the same entry form.
- Please remember that, if you own one dog yourself and another in partnership with someone else, you and the partnership rank as different owners and the dogs should NOT be entered on the same form.
- 4. Please give the date of birth correctly, especially the year. It often means expensive tele-messages or telephone calls and results in a great deal of extra work.
- 5. Please sign the Declaration and note the additional sentence at the end regarding liability.
- 6. Please state breed(s) entered in all correspondence.
- 7. Please state whether or not you are applying for membership of the Association.
- 8. Please make your cheque/Bank Draft/M.O./P.O. payable to the Gundog Breeds Association of Scotland.
- Please post your entries early. Do not wait until the closing date (15th October 2025). USE FIRST CLASS MAIL.
