RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1 The Show will open at 7.00 a.m.
- 2 Dogs will be received until 11.30 a.m. and after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by any special permission of the Show Management.
- 3 The proposed order of judging will be announced, following the closing of entries, on the Society and Higham Press websites and will be sent out with passes to those exhibitors making postal entries. All judging will commence at 9.00am unless otherwise advised in the information sent out with passes and/or published on the Society's web site.
- 4
 - a. Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed.
 - b. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to The Royal Kennel Club.
 - c. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed by which time all dogs must be removed.
- 5 **Entry Fees:** All fees include VAT (VAT Reg GB 212 0398 07). **Breeds with CCs** - On or before Wednesday 5th August £33.00, from Thursday 6th August £36.00. **Breeds without CCs, AVNSC, AV Import Register, Stakes Classes** - On or before Wednesday 5th August £18.00, from Thursday 6th August £20.00. **RKC Breeders' Competition** £15.00. **Not for Competition** - On or before Wednesday 5th August £16.00, from Thursday 6th August £18.00. **Subsequent entries with the same dog** - £7.00. **Four or more dogs with the same ownership** - On or before Wednesday 5th August £117.00, from Thursday 6th August £125.00. **Junior Handling** - £5.00. **Spectator Dog Fee** (payable on the day) - £10.00. **Catalogues** (pre-paid) £8.00 or £10.00 on the day subject to availability. **Car Parking pre-paid with entries** - £5.00/day. **Car Parking on the day** - £10.00/day. Paid up members of the Society will be sent a Members' Car Park Pass and a copy of the show schedule by post prior to the date of the show. Exhibitors arriving at the show without either a Members' or a prepaid Exhibitors' Car Park Pass will be directed to the Public Car Park. Members of the public will be admitted to the show free of charge. A designated Public Car Parking area will be available for use by visitors to the show on payment of £10/vehicle/day. **Caravans/motor homes/tents** £60.00 (pre-paid with entry fees) for nights of 9-14 September inclusive with supplement (pre-paid with entry fees) of £15.00 per night to include nights of 7-8 September or, **subject to availability of space**, £20.00/night on arrival at the show. No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct fees. **ENTRY FEES ONCE RECEIVED ARE NOT REFUNDABLE AND CAN ONLY BE REFUNDED ON PRODUCTION OF VETERINARY AND/OR MEDICAL CERTIFICATES RECEIVED PRIOR TO THE SHOW AND SUPPORTING SUCH CLAIMS.** Entry fees will not be refunded in any circumstances where any act of God or any other unforeseen reason causes the cancellation or abandonment of the show. Cheques, to be drawn on a UK bank only, should be made payable to "Richmond Dog Show Society". Entries may be made online at www.highampress.co.uk.
- 6 There will be no prize money in Breed Classes at this show. Stakes prize money is listed under the relevant Stakes Classes.
- 7 The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 8 Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition, i.e. exhibits must be born prior to 12th March 2026.
- 9 The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
- 10 **Best Puppy in Show (if scheduled)**

Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. The selection of Best in Show may follow the selection of Best Puppy in Show and Best Veteran in Show (if scheduled) respectively. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it may, at the discretion of the judge, be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it may, at the discretion of the judge, be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively.

A. **Shows judged on the Group System** - (Definition; Shows judged on Group System - Refer to Regulation F(1)27.b)

 - 1) **Best Puppy in Breed**

A Best Puppy may be declared in each breed from puppies entered and unbeaten by another puppy in the breed classes.
A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Not Separately classified class(es).
A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register class(es).

2) **Best Puppy in Group**

Best puppy in group and subsequent puppy group placings must be selected from:-

- a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed.
- b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group.
- c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group.

3) **Best Puppy in Show**

Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in group winners.

11 **Best in Show**

The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best of Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register.

A. **Shows Judged on the Group System**

1) **Best of Breed**

Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.

NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register award relevant to a Category 3 Breed will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon.

2) **Best of Group**

Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:-

- (a) The Best of Breed winners in each group.
- (b) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each Group.
- (c) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Imported Breed Register class or classes in each Group.

NOTE: The dog declared Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/ Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register from a breed designated by The Royal Kennel Club as a Category 3 Breed is not eligible to compete in the Group competition unless it has passed an examination by the Show's Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant Group.

3) **Best in Show**

Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.

- 12 Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- 13 Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Royal Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- 14 All exhibitors must be familiar with Royal Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- 15 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Royal Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 16 **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and The Royal Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at RKC licensed events.
 - When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

- 17 Anyone whose dog is entered at a Royal Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of The Royal Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under The Royal Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars or prong collars is not permitted at any show licensed by The Royal Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
- 18 Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Royal Kennel Club registered. Not for Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged 3 calendar months of age on the first day of the show.
- 19 No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the Board of The Royal Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 20 An exhibitor or competitor should ensure that contact details for any handler are available and must be provided upon request in any investigation of a breach of this regulation by such handler.
- 21 **Best Veteran in Show**
The Best Veteran in Show is a veteran which has competed and is unbeaten by any other veteran exhibited at the same show. A veteran is a dog which is aged no less than 7 years on the first day of the show, i.e. born on or before 11th September 2019.
- A. **Shows Judged on the Group System**
- 1) **Best Veteran in Breed**
Best Veteran in Breed will be selected from all unbeaten veterans from ANY breed classes provided they are not beaten by any other veteran.
 - 2) **Best Veteran in Group**
Best Veteran in Group and subsequent veteran group placings must be selected from:
 - (a) Those veterans declared Best Veteran in Breed.
 - (b) The Best Veteran from **ANY** of the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day.
 - (c) The Best Veteran from **ANY** of the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group or on each day.
 - 3) **Best Veteran in Show**
Best Veteran in Show must be selected from the Best Veteran in Group winners.
- 22 The Show will be held under Royal Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations. All exhibitors shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Royal Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations.
- 23 Entries must be posted on or before Wednesday 5th August 2026. HOWEVER, entries may be made online up to 12 noon on Monday 17th August 2026 at www.highampress.co.uk. **WE WILL BE UNABLE TO ACCEPT FURTHER ENTRIES AFTER 12 NOON ON MONDAY 17th AUGUST 2026.**
- 24 Entries will not be acknowledged unless accompanied by a stamped addressed postcard. The only proof of posting acceptable to the Royal Kennel Club is the certificate of posting, recorded delivery or registered post.
- 25 Exhibitors will receive a free, non-transferable pass for each dog entered, but in the case of a partnership entering only one dog, an additional pass will be provided.
- 26 Should any of the judges be prevented from fulfilling their engagement the Committee reserve to itself the right of appointing other judges to fulfil their duties. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition but no entry fees can be refunded.
- 27 The Committee is empowered to exclude or remove any dog that is not in a fit state for exhibition owing to disease, savage disposition or any other cause and all fees shall be forfeited.
- 28 Exhibitors are responsible for any damage done by their dogs whilst present at the show.
- 29 No part of the infrastructure of the show (including tents) may be altered in any way except by authorized personnel.
- 30 The Committee will not be responsible for the loss or damage to a dog or dogs or any property whether arising from accident or any other cause nor for any act of omission of itself, its officers, servants or others and it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.
- 31 The Committee can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold at the show.
- 32 All Rules and Regulations or definitions and instructions of the nature of rules and regulations, printed for convenience in other parts of this Schedule, shall be deemed to be regulations of the Committee and shall have the same effect as if they formed part of these Regulations. Should any question arise not provided for in these Regulations the decision of the Committee shall be final subject only to appeal to the Royal Kennel Club.
- 33 **CANCELLATION OR ABANDONMENT.** Entry fees will not be refunded in any circumstances where any act of God or any other unforeseen reason causes the cancellation or abandonment of the show.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

(Vide Royal Kennel Club Regulations for Definitions of Classes)

PUPPIES UNDER SIX CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR EXHIBITION

N.B.—The word “dog” includes both sexes

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club.

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the first closing date shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. 29th July 2026.

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. First prizes awarded in any classes defined as Special do not count towards eligibility.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

Withdrawal

The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations F(1)19.

Transfer

- (a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height or, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months of age, 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class, to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

SPECIAL NOTE TO EXHIBITORS—Please pay particular attention to all age classes. Age must be calculated as from the FIRST DAY of the Show.

MINOR PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR—For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

YEARLING—For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty-four calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

NOVICE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or three or more first prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

GRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

POST GRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

LIMIT— For dogs which have not become show Champions under Royal Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/ Green Stars or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN—For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

VETERAN—For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

CHAMPION—For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion or Show Champion under Royal Kennel Club Regulations or under any governing body recognised by the Royal Kennel Club.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS—For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a Challenge Certificate or Reserve Challenge Certificate, or for those breeds not allocated Championship Status, Best of Sex or Reserve Best of Sex at a Championship Show.

ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED—For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled. These classes are not open to breeds which are listed on the Imported Breed Register.

ANY VARIETY—A Variety Class is one in which more than one breed or variety of a breed with a breed standard can compete.

IMPORTED BREED REGISTER—For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by The Royal Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class with the Best Imported Register / Best Imported Register Puppy being eligible for Best in Group / Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show / Best Puppy in Show as relevant. Such breeds may be entered into Imported Breed Register classes and/or Any Variety, or Stakes classes, with the exception of AVNSC classes for which they are not eligible.

NOT FOR COMPETITION Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed.

ROYAL KENNEL CLUB GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME—For dogs that have achieved their GCDS Bronze Award Certificate or above.

ROYAL KENNEL CLUB BREEDERS' COMPETITION—Each team will consist of a minimum of three and maximum of four dogs of one breed, all bred by the same breeder or breeding partnership. The breeder enters the class and then arranges which dogs are exhibited on the day of the show. Please clearly state the name and affix of the registered breeder(s). Entries will not be taken on the day of the show. Teams will be awarded points/prize money in the RKC Breeders' Competition as follows: Points 1st; 30; 2nd 15; 3rd 10; 4th 5. Prize money sponsored by Agria £25 for the winner of each group. These points will be recorded in the Royal Kennel Club Breeders Competition record book through the year. The top 40 teams will qualify including the winning teams from the European and World Dog Shows' breeders competition. Our Dogs will collate the points and publish a leader board through the year.

Regulations For The Preparation of Dogs For Exhibition F (Annex B)

1. These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Royal Kennel Club licensed event. Objections may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Royal Kennel Club Rule A11.
 - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
 - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A11.
2.
 - (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show.
 - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog, or any part thereof may be performed except-
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the Board.
 - (b) The removal of dew claws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Royal Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated, in the opinion of the Board, to deceive.
4. The Board without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from The Royal Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by The Royal Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Royal Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the show secretary at his/her office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

EXHIBITORS

Gates will be open from 7.00 a.m. daily. Judging starts promptly at 9.00 a.m. unless otherwise advised in the information sent out with passes and/or published on the Society's web site or in the canine press. The proposed order of judging will be published, following the final closing of entries, in the canine press and on the Society's and Higham Press web sites. Judging may be brought forward to 8.30 a.m. in some rings. Printed copies of the show information leaflet will be provided with the passes sent out to exhibitors who make postal entries at least five working days prior to the first day of the show. Exhibitors who enter online will be notified by e-mail when their passes and the show information leaflet are available for download. All enquiries regarding the availability and delivery of passes should be made direct to Higham Press either by e-mail (admin@highampress.co.uk) or phone (01773 832 390). **Cages will not be provided.** There are no public telephones on site.

CATALOGUES

Catalogues shall be available on a pre-paid basis for collection on the relevant day(s) of the show with the proviso that catalogues which remain uncollected after 11am may be offered for re-sale. Exhibitors wishing to pre-order catalogues may do so provided the appropriate fee, £8.00 per catalogue, is received at the time of making entries. Members who are not exhibiting at the show but who may wish to pre-order a catalogue for collection on arrival at the show may do so by using the entry form enclosed with their copy of the show schedule provided it is forwarded with the appropriate fee to the Secretary no later than 21 days prior to the show. An information leaflet including details of the show layout and times of judging etc. will be available to members of the public on arrival at the show and any other information only available from the show catalogue can be obtained on enquiry at the help centre located in the show administration area.

VISITORS

Visitors to the show are admitted free of charge but please see the Car Parking section below. Adults accompanied by children and/or minors are requested to ensure that reasonable standards of adult supervision, and control, are maintained whilst within the precincts of the show.

SPEED LIMIT

All officials, exhibitors, visitors, trade stand holders and contractors, are requested to drive with due care and attention and to observe a maximum speed limit of 5 MPH whilst using the caravan and car parks and the avenue leading to and from the public highway into and out of the show ground.

CAR PARKING

Members: All paid up Members of the Society will be sent a Members' Car Park Pass prior to the show, entitling them to park their vehicle in the provided areas prior to the show. Only one such pass can be provided per membership. **Exhibitors:** Exhibitors who pre-order an exhibitor car park pass at the time of making entries and display it on arrival at the venue will be directed to the designated parking area. **Visitors:** Members of the public arriving at the venue in their own vehicles may use the public car park at a cost of £10.00 per vehicle. **Members and/or exhibitors arriving without pre-issued car park passes will be directed to the public car park.**

FACILITIES FOR THE DISABLED

Car parking facilities for the disabled will be provided. Only vehicles displaying an official government issued disabled drivers' permit will be allowed to use this facility. Assistance for disabled persons to gain access to the show ground will be provided at the main entrance to the show. Toilets for the disabled will be available on the show ground.

CARAVANS, MOTORHOMES & TENTS

A temporary caravan park without hook-up utilities will be provided at the venue. Use of the caravan site from noon on Wednesday 9th September until noon on Monday 14th September at a cost of £60 if prepaid at the time of making entries. Early occupancy (i.e. Monday 7th & Tuesday 8th September) for a supplemental charge of £15/night (pre-booked). Short-stay occupancy (i.e. for one or two consecutive nights only) will be available at a charge of £20/night (payable on arrival and subject to availability of space). The Society's appointed Warden will control the site. Caravan labels will be provided with entry passes and MUST be displayed at all times.

DOGS LEFT IN VEHICLES

The Committee reserves the right to refuse the entries for future shows from exhibitors found to have left dogs in vehicles in a distressed condition. Remedial action will be taken if necessary. All such occurrences will be reported to The Royal Kennel Club.

UNENTERED DOGS

A TENT FOR UNENTERED DOGS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED. Dogs aged four months and over may be entered NOT FOR COMPETITION at £16.00 per dog when making postal or online entries. Alternatively, unentered dogs may be brought to the show and admitted as a SPECTATOR DOG at a cost of £10.00 per dog, provided the owner agrees to sign an undertaking to control their dog(s) whilst at the show.

PHOTOGRAPHY & VIDEO RIGHTS

The Organisers would like to bring the regulation on photography and filming to the attention of exhibitors, trade stand holders, press and visitors. It is a condition of all those attending the event that no filming or other form of recording may be taken or

made without express written permission of the Organisers. The taking of photographs in the show venue for sale or reward is strictly prohibited except with the written permission of the Organisers. Press accredited photographers are provided with permission to take photographs ONLY for use in newspapers, magazines and internet-sites for news purposes only. There is no objection to the general public taking photographs of general views of the Show, provided that these are for private use. Specific dogs may be photographed only with the approval of the exhibitor. No photography or filming is permitted in breed judging rings whilst judging is actually taking place. However, judges may allow it to happen at the end of classes or after the Challenge Certificate is awarded. Filming and flash photography is allowed from outside the rings at all times unless the operation of the camera is actually affecting exhibits. However, if a powerful flash unit is used or it is clear that exhibits are being affected, a ring steward or the judge is empowered to stop the person concerned.

CATERING ARRANGEMENTS

Refreshments, including hot food and beverages, will be available for purchase from a variety of mobile catering units. A public bar facility will be available from 11.00 a.m. daily.

We regret that we can no longer offer the facility to pay by Credit/Debit card for entries received by post. The Society is unable to accept Eurocheques or cheques drawn on overseas banks. Exhibitors are asked to note that cheques must be in order for immediate presentation and payment. Those that are not so for any reason (including technical irregularities) will not be accepted and the entries will be returned.

Requests to alter entry forms are subject to approval by the Committee in ALL instances and if accepted will be subject to a £5.00 administration charge. Requests to alter entry forms or online entries can only be accepted in written or electronic form. Requests to alter postal entry forms must be clearly signed and dated by the exhibitor. Requests to alter online entries must be sent to admin@highampress.co.uk together with a copy of the confirmation e-mail containing the exhibitors corresponding entry form number and the payment reference number. No alterations will be accepted in the case of postal entries after Wednesday 5th August 2026 or after noon on Monday 17th August 2026 in the case of online entries made at www.highampress.co.uk.
