ABUSIVE BEHAVIOUR

The Society will not tolerate any kind of abusive behaviour to its Officers, Committee or Staff on the Showground or car parks. Anyone found to be behaving in this manner will be asked to leave and a report will be sent to The Royal Kennel Club.

DISABLED DRIVERS

FOULING

Any owner, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove, as soon as possible, any fouling caused by their dog(s) within the licenced venue and within the environs of the event including car parks and approaches. Adequate receptacles for the disposal of such fouling will be provided by the Society.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR PUPPY IS ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY

(ie over 6 calendar months of age on the FIRST day of the show)
PUPPIES BORN AFTER 3rd MARCH 2026 ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY AT THIS SHOW. Puppies born on or before 3rd June 2026 may be entered 'NOT FOR COMPETITION'.
Please note that an administration charge of £5.00 will be deducted before the entry fee is refunded.

DOGS NOT FOR COMPETITION

Dogs may be entered **NOT FOR COMPETITION.**
Entry to be made on the entry form in the usual way, **giving full details of each dog.**
Please note puppies under 3 months of age are not eligible to enter the showground.

UNENTERED DOGS

You can enter dogs as NOT FOR COMPETITION (at a cost of £5 per dog). Please refer to Not For Competition details above. Alternatively, unentered dogs may be brought to the Show on the day and admitted as a SPECTATOR DOG (At a cost of £5 per dog). Upon arrival at the Show you will need to complete the necessary Royal Kennel Club Form, giving an undertaking that you will keep your dog under control at all times.

PHOTOGRAPHY & VIDEO RECORDING

The Organisers would like to bring the regulation on photography and filming to the attention of exhibitors, trade stands, press and visitors. It is a condition of all those attending the event that no filming or other form of recording may be taken or made at the venue without express written permission of the organisers. The taking of photographs in the show venue for sale or reward is strictly prohibited except with the written permission of the Organisers. Press accredited photographers are provided with permission to take photographs ONLY for use in newspapers, magazines and internet sites – this is for news purposes only. There is no objection to the general public taking photographs of general views of the show, provided that these are for private use. Specific dogs may be photographed only with the approval of the exhibitor. No photography or filming is permitted in breed judging rings whilst judging is actually taking place. However, judges may allow it to happen at the end of classes or after the Challenge Certificate is awarded. Filming and flash photography is allowed from outside the rings at all times unless the operation of the camera is actually affecting exhibits. However, if a powerful flash unit is used or it is clear that exhibits are being affected, a ring steward or the judge is empowered to stop the person concerned.

Susan Manning BVSc (Hons) DVOPhthal MRCVS (BVA/RKC/ISDS Eye Panellist) will be in attendance on each day of the show to carry out routine Eye Testing under the BVA/RKC/ISDS Scheme which will include the following tests

Please Note: Mydriatic drops which dilate the pupils will be used in all eye tests, allowing a more satisfactory examination. The drops are short acting and will not affect the dogs' performance in the ring. (You may wish for testing to be delayed until after your judging).

All dogs tested under the RKC/BVA/ISDS Scheme must have an identifying chip, which must be readable at the time of the examination for a certificate to be issued.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Vicious dogs are not eligible and must not be brought to the Show

Exhibitors are held responsible for any damage done by their dog during the exhibition.

- 1 The Show will open at 7.30 a.m. daily.
- 2 Dogs will be received at any time from 7.30 a.m. until 12 noon but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
- 3 Breed Judging will start at 9.00 a.m. on all days unless otherwise notified or published in the dog press or **with the exhibitors passes**. Exhibitors will be responsible for their dogs being in the ring in time for judging.
- 4 Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to The Royal Kennel Club. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed at which time dogs must be removed.
- 5 Details of Entry Fees are on page 2. All entry fees and other charges quoted in this Schedule and on the entry form are inclusive of V.A.T. **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED ONCE AN ENTRY HAS BEEN MADE. Entries may be made online at www.highampress.co.uk**
- 6 Prize money under the relevant Stakes classes: **Prize money must be claimed on the day.**
- 7 The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 8 Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition, ie born on or after 4th March 2026. Puppies born on or before 3rd June 2026 may be entered Not For Competition.
- 9 The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
- 10 **Best Puppy in Show** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. The selection of Best in Show may follow the selection of Best Puppy in Show and Best Veteran in Show (if scheduled) respectively. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it may, at the discretion of the judge, be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it may, at the discretion of the judge, be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively.
 - a **Shows Judged on the Group System**
Definition; Shows judged on Group System - Refer to Regulation F(1) (27B.)
 - 1) **Best Puppy in Breed**
A Best Puppy may be declared in each breed from puppies entered and unbeaten by another puppy in the breed classes.
A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Not Separately classified class(es).
A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register class(es).
 - 2) **Best Puppy in Group**
Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Puppy Group placings must be selected from:-
 - a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed
 - b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group.
 - c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group.
 - 3) **Best Puppy in Show**
Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners.
- 11 **Best in Show**
The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best of Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register.
 - a **Shows Judged on the Group System**
 - 1) **Best of Breed**
Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.
NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/ Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register award relevant to a Category 3 Breed will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon.
 - 2) **Best of Group**
Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:-
 - a) The Best of Breed winners in each group
 - b) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each Group.
 - c) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Imported Breed Register class or classes in each Group.

NOTE: The dog declared Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/ Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register from a breed designated by The Royal Kennel Club as a Category 3 Breed is not eligible to compete in the Group competition unless it has passed an examination by the Show's

Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant Group.

3) **Best in Show**

Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.

- 12 Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- 13 Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Royal Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- 14 All exhibitors must be familiar with Royal Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B): Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- 15 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Royal Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 16 **Dogs in Vehicles on Hot Days:** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and The Royal Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at Royal Kennel Club licensed events.
 - When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare. **WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK, FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**
- 17 Anyone whose dog is entered at a Royal Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of The Royal Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Royal Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by The Royal Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
- 18 **Not For Competition.** Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Royal Kennel Club registered. Not for Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged 3 calendar months of age on the first day of the show.
- 19 No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the Board of The Royal Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 20 An exhibitor or competitor should ensure that contact details for any handler are available and must be provided upon request in any investigation of a breach of this regulation by such handler.
- 21 **Cancellation or Abandonment:** Entry fees will not be refunded in any circumstance where any act of God or any other unforeseen reason causes the cancellation or abandonment of the show.
- 22 The Show will be held under Royal Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations. Every exhibitor making an entry or entries at or for this Show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by The Royal Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations and by these regulations, and it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.
- 23 All postal and online entries must be made on or before **Monday 13th July 2026**. Changes to entries can only be made on application to the Secretary, before closing of entries.
- 24 **If acknowledgement of entries is required, a stamped postcard/envelope with "receipt" written on the reverse side should be enclosed with entries.**
- 25 **Exhibitors will receive one pass (not transferable) for each dog entered. If Exhibitor's passes have not been received, or if you have any queries, Higham Press should be contacted direct on 01773 832390.**
- 26 The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Royal Kennel Club licensed events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car parks and approaches.
- 27 All dogs must be removed from their halls within 30 minutes of the completion of Group judging on the first, second and third days, and after the Best in Show judging on the final day.

- 28 This show is held exempt from Royal Kennel Club benching regulations. Areas for cages and crates are available adjacent to all rings. Gangways will be clearly marked and exhibitors are reminded not to obstruct gangways, and wherever requested observe the instructions of the Safety Stewards to maintain clear access and respect other exhibitors. Exhibitors should ensure that cages/crates are affixed with a label detailing the name of the dog/dogs and name and contact details of the owner.
- 29 Dogs may not be present at the ringside, except when their breed is being judged at the same time.
- 30 **Gangways must be kept clear at all times.** Royal Kennel Club Regulation F(1)3d applies. The Committee will not be responsible for Exhibitors missing their classes.
- 31 Conversation not allowed in the judging ring. Exhibitors showing dogs are not allowed to hold conversation with the Judges during the competition. **No persons other than Exhibitors (Officials excepted) will be allowed in the ring during the judging of classes or specials.**
- 32 **Change of Judge:** Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement, the Committee reserves the right to appoint a substitute. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition, **but no entry fees can be returned.**
- 33 The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of the dogs brought for competition, but it must be distinctly understood that the Committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of or damage whatever, or from any act of omission of themselves, their Officers, agents, servants or others.
- 34 Should any question arise, not provided for by these Regulations or by The Royal Kennel Club Rules, the decision of the Committee shall be final, subject only to appeal to The Royal Kennel Club.
- 35 **DOGS IN VEHICLES: THE COMMITTEE WILL REFUSE ENTRIES FROM ANY EXHIBITOR PROVED, TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE COMMITTEE, TO HAVE LEFT ANY DOG OR DOGS IN A DISTRESSED CONDITION IN ANY MOTOR VEHICLE AT THE SHOW.**
- 36 Every exhibitor shall ensure that whilst the dog is being exhibited, its handler shall display the correct ring number.

NO DOGS SHOULD BE LEFT UNATTENDED AT ANY SHOW FOR VERY LONG PERIODS. THE ROYAL KENNEL CLUB'S ADVICE TO DOG OWNERS AND BREED SOCIETIES SHOULD BE STUDIED CAREFULLY CONCERNING DOGS AT SHOWS.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

(Vide Royal Kennel Club Regulations for Definitions of Classes)

PUPPIES UNDER SIX CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR EXHIBITION

PUPPIES MUST HAVE BEEN BORN ON OR BEFORE 3rd MARCH 2026

N.B.—The word “dog” includes both sexes

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club.

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the first closing date shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. **6th July 2026.**

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. First prizes awarded in any classes defined as special do not count towards eligibility.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

Withdrawal

The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations F(1) 19.

Transfer

(a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

(b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months of age, 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class, to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

(c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

(d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR—For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

YEARLING—For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

GRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

POST GRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

LIMIT—For dogs which have not become Show Champions under Royal Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won seven or more First Prizes in all, at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

OPEN—For all dogs of the breeds or varieties for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

VETERAN—For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS—For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a Challenge Certificate or Reserve Challenge Certificate, or for those breeds not allocated Championship Status, Best of Sex or Reserve Best of Sex at a Championship Show.

CHAMPION—For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion or Show Champion under Royal Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club.

SPECIAL RACING OR LURE COURSING: For Royal Kennel Club Registered Greyhounds that must also be registered with the GBGB or the NCC.

ANY VARIETY IMPORTED REGISTER BREEDS For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by The Royal Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class with the Best Imported Register / Best Imported Register Puppy being eligible for Best in Group / Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show / Best Puppy in Show as relevant. Such breeds may be entered into Imported Breed Register classes and/or Any Variety or Stakes classes, with the exception of AVNSC classes, for which they are not eligible.

ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED— For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled. These classes are not open to breeds which are listed on the Imported Breed Register.

YOUNG ROYAL KENNEL CLUB MEMBERS' STAKES (Crufts 2027 Qualifier) All of the following YRKC Stakes specific rules are to be read in conjunction with the full rules available on the YRKC website and by entering this class you confirm that you have fully read and understood those rules:

- YRKC members and their reps agree to abide the YRKC code of conduct.
- You must be a current YRKC member to enter YRKC AV Stakes classes.
- YRKC AV Stakes classes may be the first and only entry at this show.
- YRKC AV Stakes classes have one age category for all members to enter (06-24 years).
- For entry into YRKC AV Stakes classes, dogs must registered be on the Royal Kennel Club breed register.
- Dogs entered on this class must be registered on their relevant breed register AND the YRKC member entering the dog MUST have a family connection to the dog (please read the rules for a full explanation and any exceptions).
- First and second place in each sub-category will guarantee qualification to Crufts 2027 (when placing in a class, please ensure that the steward takes down your name and YRKC membership number to record on the scoresheet).
- You may enter this class even if you have previously qualified in this class.
- Please note, the qualification year for Crufts 2027 will be from 1st November 2025 to 31 Oct 2026.

YOUNG ROYAL KENNEL CLUB MEMBERS' HANDLING CLASSES All of the following YRKC handling specific rules are to be read in conjunction with the full rules available on the YRKC website and by entering this class you confirm that you have fully read and understood those rules:

- YRKC members and their reps agree to abide the YRKC code of conduct.
- YRKC Handling judging will be in accordance with the YRKC Handling Judging Criteria.
- You must be a current YRKC member to enter YRKC handling classes.
- YRKC handling classes may be the first and only entry at this show.
- A show offering YRKC handling classes will be offering 3 different classes: 06-11 years; 12-17 years; 18-24 years.
- YRKC Members should enter the age category they would be on the first day of this show.
- Any breed of dog (including Crossbreeds) may be entered into any of the YRKC handling classes at this show. For entry into YRKC handling classes, dogs must be on either the Royal Kennel Club breed register or the Royal Kennel Club activity register.
- A handler not enter the same dog into multiple handling classes at the same show.
- After entries have closed, competitors may only switch dogs if both (1) The dog has not already entered (or has already competed in) another YRKC handling class at the same show; (2) The dog must already be entered at the show (i.e. the breed class).
- First and second place in each age category will guarantee qualification to Crufts 2027. When placing in a class, please ensure that the steward takes down your name and YRKC membership number to record on the scoresheet.

ROYAL KENNEL CLUB BREEDERS' COMPETITION—Each team will consist of a minimum of three and maximum of four dogs of one breed, all bred by the same breeder or breeding partnership. The breeder enters the class and then arranges which dogs are exhibited on the day of the show. Please clearly state the name and affix of the registered breeder(s). Entries will not be taken on the day of the show. Teams will be awarded points/prize money in the RKC Breeders' Competition as follows: Points 1st; 30; 2nd 15; 3rd 10; 4th 5. Prize Money £25 for all group winners. These points will be recorded in The Royal Kennel Club Breeders Competition record book through the year. The top 40 teams will qualify including the winning teams from the European and World Dog Shows' breeders competition. Our Dogs will collate the points and publish a leader board through the year.

ANY VARIETY GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME CLASS — For dogs which have achieved their Good Citizen Dog Scheme Bronze award certificate or above.

VULNERABLE NATIVE BREEDS STAKES — Open to dogs from breeds on The Royal Kennel Club list of Vulnerable Native Breeds.

NOT FOR COMPETITION— Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed. Dogs entered NFC must be over 3 months old on the day they are entered.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F(B)

- 1 These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Royal Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Royal Kennel Club Rule A11.
 - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
 - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A11.
 - 2
 - (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.
 - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
 - 3 No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the Board.
 - (b) The removal of dew claws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding, provided that such operations are notified to The Royal Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.
- Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the Board to deceive.
- 4 The Board without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from The Royal Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
 - 5 An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by The Royal Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Royal Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
 - 6 Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

The attention of exhibitors is drawn to the fact that any advertisement for a coat preparation or shampoo or similar in either Schedule or Catalogue does not imply that the use of such preparation may not contravene Royal Kennel Club Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition-F. This also applies to any coat preparation or shampoo or similar on sale at The City of Birmingham Dog Show. The attention of exhibitors is directed to the declaration they are required to sign on the Entry form.

The Order of Judging is not published in this schedule but will be sent out with exhibitor's passes.

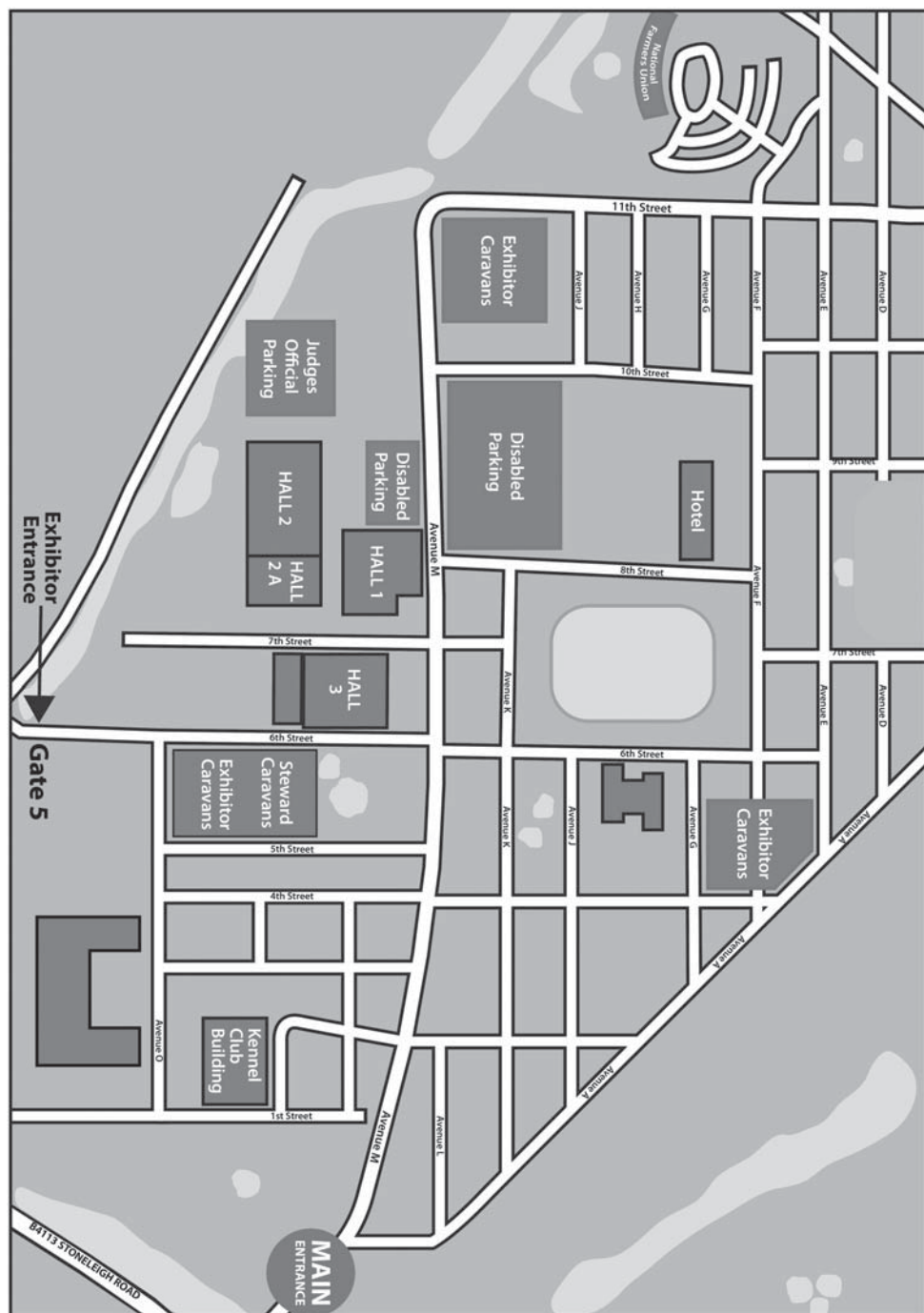

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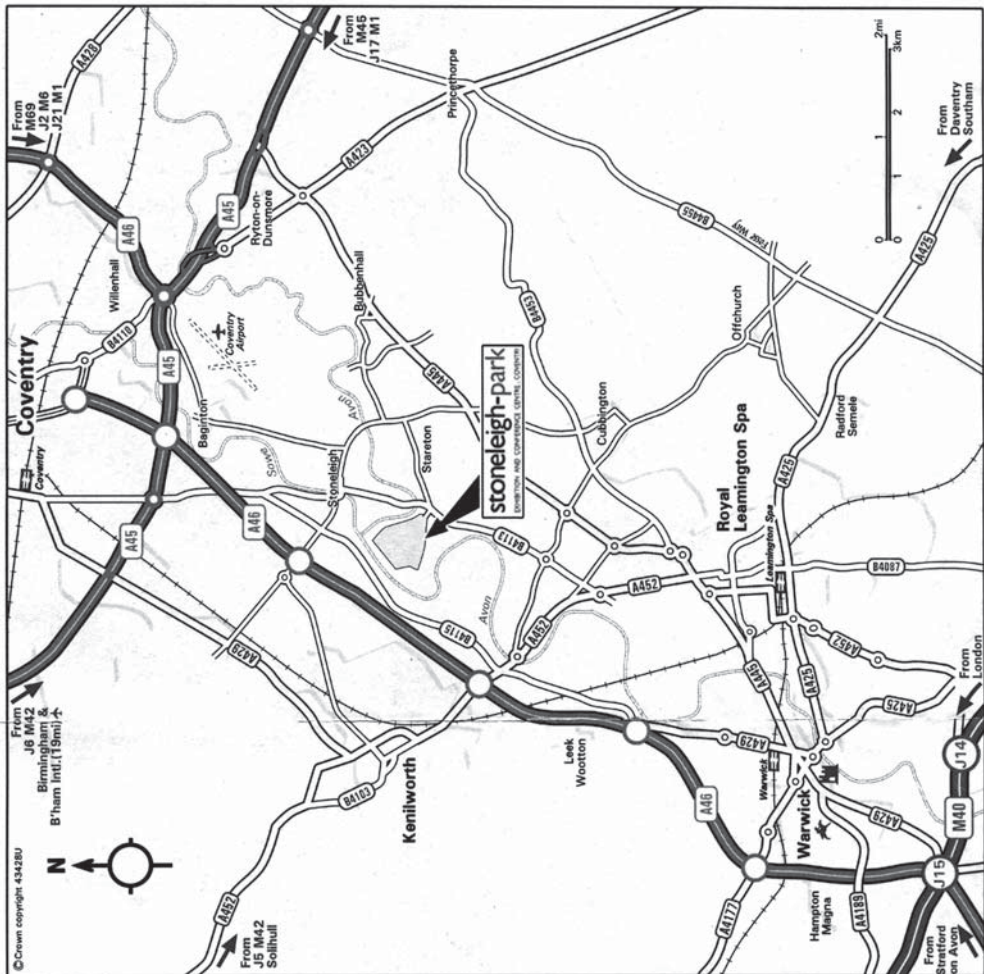
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- **From London and M40** Leave the M40 at junction 15 and join the A46 dual carriageway towards Coventry.
- Follow the signs for National Agricultural Centre or NAC Stoneleigh Park until you pick up the signs for Stoneleigh Park. These signs will direct you to Stoneleigh Park Main Entrance on the B4113.
- **From the M6 or M69** Leave the M6 motorway at junction 2 and join the A46 towards Warwick. Or, at the conclusion of the M69, continue onto the A46 towards Warwick and the M40.
- Follow the signs for National Agricultural Centre or NAC Stoneleigh Park until you pick up the signs for Stoneleigh Park. These signs will direct you to Stoneleigh Park Main Entrance on the B4113.
- **From the Northbound M1** Leave the M1 at junction 17, to join the M45 towards Coventry.
- Stay on the M45 until you see signs for A45 Coventry (not A45 Coventry). Follow the A45 until you pick up signs for A46 Warwick.
- Follow the signs for National Agricultural Centre or NAC Stoneleigh Park until you pick up the signs for Stoneleigh Park. These signs will direct you to Stoneleigh Park Main Entrance on the B4113.
- **By Train**
 - **From London to Coventry:** Services every half hour (daytime Mon-Fri). Directions between London Euston and Coventry. Scheduled journey times may vary but are generally less than 1 hour 15 minutes.
